## Rules of Play

- All players 49 years of age and younger will play from the blue tees.
- All players 50-64 years of age will play from the white tees.
- All players 65 years of age and older will play from the gold tees.
- You may move your ball 6 inches, no closer to the hole, in your own fairway, unless otherwise specified.
- The highest score you can make on any hole is double bogey.
- Hole every putt for bogey or less, nothing is “good”
- You may tap down spike marks.
- All other USGA rules apply.
- In the event that you and anyone else in your group cannot agree on a ruling, play a second ball, and the appropriate ruling will be made at the completion of play.

## Pairings / Team Partners

- You may pick your cart partner to play golf with for that day, but not your foursome.
- Singles will either be paired or be put in a threesome.
- Twosomes are then randomly paired to determine groupings and tee order.
- Team partners are drawn separately from groups/pairings.
- All participating players are divided by handicap (high & low).
- Team pairings are blindly drawn. Each team has 1 high & 1 low handicap.

## Entry Fee

- \$22.00 per person. This fee is broken down as follows:
  - \$8 – Handicapped team play (2 man bestball using 80% of handicap on course. Pays front 9 & back 9)
  - \$7 – Skins Game
  - \$4 – Pin Shots (\$1 for each par 3)
  - \$1 - Low Net (score minus 100% of handicap)
  - \$2 - League Fee (pays for year-end league prizes)
- Please put in your entry fee at the completion of your round!

All players are subject to a one time \$15 member fee only if you:

- Win any money.
- Attend any one of our three league cook-outs.  
(member fees collected pay for food and beverages at our cook-outs)

## **League Points**

- You will receive one(1) league point for each of the following:
  - Showing up and playing golf.
  - Winning a skin
  - Winning front nine team (or tying for low)
  - Winning back nine team (or tying for low)
  - Winning low net (or tying for low)
  - Winning a pin shot
- All league points are tracked and posted throughout the season
- Top 32 players on the points list qualify for league match play beginning August 31, 2014.

## **Match Play**

- Match play seedings are set, based on the year end points list
- Single elimination match play begins 8/31/14 using 90% of handicap
- Match play prizes are expected to be as follows:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> place (5-0) - \$200
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> place (4-1) - \$140
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> place (3-1) - \$100
  - 4<sup>th</sup> Place (3-1) - \$80
  - T 5<sup>th</sup> place (2-1) - \$60
  - T 9<sup>th</sup> place (1-1) - \$40
  - T 17<sup>th</sup> place (0-1) - \$20
- Trophies that will be presented at the end of the year are:
  - The Bob Whelan Cup – awarded to the winner of match play
  - Wooden Plaque with entire match play results – to winner
  - The Bob Baker Trophy – awarded to the year end points leader (plus a case of beer)
