

The Sunbelt Senior Professional Golf Tour was founded in 1996 in Myrtle Beach, SC by PGA Life Member, Don Barnes. The original goal was to provide playing opportunities for quality senior golfers, contribute to local charities, make an economic impact in smaller communities, and provide positive publicity for its sponsor/partners and it remains the same today.

Several hundred tournaments have been conducted since the inception with all tournaments played in the greater Myrtle Beach area over the first three seasons.

Since that time, tournaments have expanded into Florida, Georgia, Alabama, Tennessee, Mississippi, Ohio, West Virginia, Pennsylvania, New York, New Jersey, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Cancun, Mexico.

Over \$5 million has been paid in professional purses. Over \$4 million has been raised for various charities.
